AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF JEANNETTE DESIGNATING THAT ROADWAY EXTENDING FROM THE CLAY AVENUE EXTENSION TO AND THROUGH THE JEANNETTE INDUSTRIAL PARK AS "JAYHAWK DRIVE"

WHEREAS, the Westmoreland County Industrial Development Corporation (WCIDC) is the owner of that certain parcel of property abutting the Clay Avenue Extension in the City of Jeannette, Westmoreland County, Pennsylvania, such property being generally known as the "Jeannette Industrial Park"; and

WHEREAS, the WCIDC has solicited tenants to occupy such Industrial Park; and
WHEREAS, the roadway extending from the Clay Avenue Extension into the Industrial
Park is at this point in time an unnamed private roadway maintained by the WCIDC; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the City of Jeannette to designate and adopt a name for such roadway at this point in time to enable tenants occupying the Jeannette Industrial Park to receive mail and other essential public services.

NOW, THEREFORE, WITH THE FOREGOING RECITALS BEING
INCORPORATED HEREIN, THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JEANNETTE HEREBY
ORDAINS AND ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the private roadway and/or portion of private roadway extending from the line of the Clay Avenue Extension into and through the property of the WCIDC (known as the

"Jeannette Industrial Park") shall be and is hereafter named, designated and known as "Jayhawk Drive".

- 2. The purposes of such designation is to provide mailing addresses for tenants occupying space within the aforesaid Industrial Park, to provide notice to taxing authorities and to locate tenants for access by and to essential public services.
- 3. Nothing in the enactment of this Ordinance shall be deemed or construed as an acceptance of such roadway by the City of Jeannette as a public roadway; provided, however, that the City may accept such roadway as a public street within the City of Jeannette upon its final completion and formal dedication by the WCIDC.

THIS ORDINANCE IS DULY ORDAINED AND ENACTED AT A PUBLIC MEETING OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JEANNETTE HELD THIS 17 DAY OF JADUARY, 2000 AND SHALL TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.
