AN ORDINANCE AMENDING A PORTION OF SECTION V OF ORDINANCE NO. 36 OF THE CITY OF JEANNETTE, SPECIFICALLY AMENDING THE PROVISIONS ESTABLISHING THE RATES FOR SEWAGE SERVICE TO INDUSTRIAL USERS.

WHEREAS, the City of Jeannette has received its Industrial Wastewater Study, Phase I, dated 1979, as prepared by Gannett Fleming Corddry and Carpenter, Inc., consulting engineers to the City of Jeannette; and;

WHEREAS, the report identified above is incorporated herein by reference, made a part hereof and marked Exhibit "A"; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Jeannette is desirous of increasing the rate for sewage treatment charged to industrial users to reflect the actual cost of service based on waste water introduced into the system.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the above, it is hereby ordained and enacted by the Council of the City of Jeannette, at a regular meeting thereof, held on the May of June, 1980, as follows:

SECTION I. That Section V of Ordinance No. 36 is hereby amended to read as follows:

INDUSTRIAL USERS

Service Connection Minimum \$130.00/year
Each Employee, \$3.90/year
but not less than \$1.054/1,000 gallons
of water returned to sewer.

Strength of Waste Surcharge:

Pollutant	Threshold	Rate per PPM
BOD	N Al 15 (542-543-55)	6
(Biochemical Oxygen Demand)	200 PPM	\$0.0017/1,000 gal.
SS		
(Suspended Solids)	250 PPM	\$0.0007/1,000 gal.

Further, Industry shall install water meters or other devices to measure water consumption discharged to Sewer System. Industry shall pay all costs for laboratory tests to determine BOD and SS content of wastes discharged from the industry. Strengths of waste surcharge are expressed as Dollars per volume of water consumed for each PPM by which the pollutant exceeds the threshold, and will be assessed against the industrial user introducing same into the system.

SECTION II. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION III. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage.
