ORDINANCE NO. 80_//

AN ORDINANCE VACATING A CERTAIN PORTION OF AN UNOPENED ALLEY, 15 FEET IN WIDTH LYING BETWEEN LAFFERTY AND GOOD STREET IN THE 2ND WARD AND RUNNING IN A GENERAL NORTHEASTERLY DIRECTION 93.65 FEET FROM ITS INTERSECTION WITH FROTHINGHAM AVENUE ON THE SOUTHWEST.

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Jeannette has received a Petition from the owners of all the property situate along a certain unopened portion of a 15 foot wide alley, lying between Lafferty and Good Streets in the 2nd Ward of the City of Jeannette asking for the vacation of same, from its intersection with Frothingham Avenue on the southwest, 93.65 feet to a point on the northeasterly side of said alley, and;

WHEREAS, the portion of said Frothingham Avenue mentioned herein has been previously vacated by said Council of the City of Jeannette, and;

WHEREAS, upon the recommendation of the City Engineer and the Chief of Fire of the City of Jeannette who reviewed the proposed vacation and find no objection to same, and;

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Jeannette is desirous of vacating same,

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of same, it is hereby ordained and enacted by the Council of the City of Jeannette, at a regular meeting thereof, held on the // day of JUNE 1980, as follows:

SECTION I. The unopened portion of that certain 15 foot wide alley lying between Lafferty and Good Streets in the 2nd Ward of the City of Jeannette, from its intersection with Frothingham Avenue on the Southwest, a distance of 93.65 feet to a point northeasterly from the place of beginning is and be hereby vacated.

SECTION II. That portion of said unopened alley hereby vacated shall revert to and become the property of those property owners abutting said vacated portion of the 15 foot alley.
