ORDINANCE NO. 80-1/6

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION V OF ORDINANCE NO 36 OF THE CITY OF JEANNETTE ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING SEWAGE RENTALS FOR THE USE OF THE SEWAGE SYSTEM AND SEWAGE TREATMENT WORKS OF THE CITY OF JEANNETTE, AND PROVIDING FOR THE COLLECTION THEREOF, AND THE LIENING OF PROPERTY FOR NON-PAYMENT THEREOF", AS AMENDED, AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES INCONSISTENT HEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, and it is hereby Ordained and Enacted by the Council of the City of Jeannette that Ordinance No. 36 of the City of Jeannette entitled "AN ORDINANCE establishing sewage rentals for the use of sewage system and sewage treatment works of the City of Jeannette, and providing for the collection thereof, and the liening of property for non-payment thereof", Ordained and Enacted by the Council of the City of Jeannette on the 20th day of July, 1939, as amended, be and is herby amended as follows:

SECTION I. That Section V of Ordinance No. 36 is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION V. The following annual rates for service are hereby established;

DOMESTIC USERS

Domestic Users shall be charged at the annual rate of Seventy Five and no/100 (\$75.00) dollars per year.

COMMERCIALS USERS

Rates based on water consumption:

INDUSTRIAL USERS

Service Connection Minimum \$151.45/year Each Employee, \$4.54/year but not less than \$1.230/1,000 gallons of water returned to sewer.

Strength of Waste Surcharge:

POLLUTANT	THRESHOLD	RATE PER PPM
BOD (Biochemical Oxygen Demand) SS	200 PPM	\$0.0019805/1,000 gal.
(Suspended Solids)	250 PPM	\$0.0008155/1,000 gal.

Further, Industry shall install water meters or other devices to measure water consumption discharged to Sewer System. Industry shall pay all costs for laboratory tests to determine BOD and SS content of wastes discharged from the industry. Strengths of waste surcharge are expressed as Dollars per volume of water consumed for each PPM by which the pollutant exceeds the threshold, and will be assessed against the industrial user introducing same into the system.

SECTION II. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION III. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage.
