AN ORDINANCE of the City of Jeannette amending the salary ordinance specifically that section which provides for the rates of pay for the meterperson Clarence Copeland.

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the Council of the City of Jeannette that the salary paid to Clarence Copeland did not properly reflect the increase due to the raising of the federal minimum wage and the general across the board pay increase of 9% granted to City Employees, and;

WHEREFORE, Council is desirous of adjusting his salary to reflect the increase in the federal minimum wage and to reflect the general salary increase granted to City Employees.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the above, it is hereby ordained and enacted by the Council of the City of Jeannette, at a regular meeting thereof held on the State day of April, 1981, that

- 1. That section of the salary ordinance establishing the salary to be paid to Clarence Copeland be and is hereby amended to adjust the rate to \$3.65 per hour.
- All Ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
