ORDINANCE NO. 82-8

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF JEANNETTE AUTHORIZING KENNETH A. CARASIA OF 106 HARRISON AVENUE, JEANNETTE, TO STORE AND KEEP A HORSE ON HIS PREMISES SITUATE SOUTHWESTHERLY OF ROUTE 130, COMMONLY REFERRED TO AS HARRISON AVENUE.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the Council of the City of Jeannette, at a regular meeting thereof, held on the day of June, 1982 that:

WHEREAS, Council has received a request and petition, attached hereto and made a part hereof, from Kenneth A. Carasia of 106 Harrison Avenue, Jeannette to store and maintain a horse on his premises, described as parcel 14 of the accompanying petition, and;

WHEREAS, Council has specific power to control and regulate stock and domestic animals in 53 P.S. 37403 Section 8, and

WHEREAS, Council is desirous of granting petitioners request, provided all the safeguards are compiled with

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the above Council adopts the following:

SECTION 1. Kenneth A. Carasia is hereby authorized and permitted to Board and maintain a horse on the 24 acre parcel of ground as more fully described in the attached petition.

SECTION 11. Kenneth A. Carasia shall assume complete responsibility for any health or safety hazards created by the boarding of said horse.

SECTION 111. The authority is limited to the boarding of one male horse and this permission is not to be expanded to any additional.

SECTION 1V. The authority is non-transferrable and shall be personal in nature only for Kenneth A. Carasia.

SECTION V. Any violation of this ordinance shall automatically revoke the authority granted herein and the City shall be entitled to enforce any legal remedy available to the City.

SECTION V1. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
