Ordinance No. 87-//

An Ordinance of the City of Jeannette amending a portion of Ordinance No. 59-22 providing for the termination of benefits under the Police Retirement Plan for a widow who entered into a marriage with an officer after his official retirement date.

Be it ordained and enacted, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the Council of the City of Jeannette, at a regular meeting thereof, held on the <u>Motor day of September</u>, 1987, that;

WHEREAS, the police pension board has recommended to the City Council the adoption of an amendment to the police pension plan to terminate widow's benefits to a surviving widow of a police officer, when the officer and the spouse entered into the marriage after the official retirement date of the officer, and;

WHEREAS, the City Council has reviewed the proposal and deems it is in the best interest of the plan to promote sound fiscal planning of assets and distribution to terminate benefits to a widow of an officer who entered into the marriage after retirement;

NOW, THEREFORE, intending to be legally bound, the Council of the City of Jeannette adopts the following:

1. The police pension plan is hereby amended to exclude and terminate the fenefits payable under the plan to a widow, surviving an officer, if the marriage was entered into after the officer's effective and official retirement date.

- 2. No widow surviving an officer, who was married to the officer during any period prior to his retirement, shall be affected by this ordinance.
- 3. Any ordinances or parts of ordinance inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
- 4. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage.
