ORDINANCE NO. 90-2

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF JEANNETTE VACATING AN UNNAMED IMPROVED ALLEY SITUATE ADJACENT TO JEANNETTE DISTRICT MEMORIAL HOSPITAL.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, and it is hereby Ordained and Enacted by the Council of the City of Jeannette, at a regular meeting thereof, held on the 7th. day of March, 1990 that,

WHEREAS: the owners of property abutting that portion of an unnamed and improved alley adjacent to the Jeannette District Memorial Hospital, have petitioned the Council to vacate same, and;

WHEREAS: the aforesaid portion of an unnamed and improved alley has been reviewed by the City Engineer, Fire Chief and Police Chief and further no harm or danger to the public health or safety would result from the proposed vacation.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the above, and in further consideration of the recommendations of the City Officers aforesaid and intending to be legally bound hereby, Council adopts the following:

- 1) That portion of the within described unnamed and improved right of way be and is hereby vacated.
- 2) The premises hereby vacated shall revert to and become the property of the adjoining property owners from the centerline of the existing right of way.
- 3) The City reserves unto itself, its successors or assigns any existing right of way or easements for sanitary or storm sewers for the express purpose of maintenance, repair or replacement.
- 4) The City also requires that proper access to the unnamed alley to the rear of Westmoreland Avenue be provided for all emergency vehicles by the petitioner.
- 5) All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
