1. A motion to introduce and conduct the first reading of **Ordinance 23-07**  
**An Ordinance of the City of Jeannette, Westmoreland County, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, fixing the tax rates for 2024 and appropriating specific sums estimated to be required for the specific purposes of municipal government, hereinafter set forth, for 2024.**
2. A motion to approve the Jeannette Redevelopment Authority use of the Magee Lot on Sunday May 26<sup>th</sup>, June 23<sup>rd</sup>, July 28<sup>th</sup>, August 25<sup>th</sup>, September 22<sup>nd</sup> 2024 for their Community Flea Markets, Pending approval of police chief, Fire Chief, and Solicitor.
3. A motion to approve payment to Secure Technical Solutions in the amount of \$31,877.70 for cameras to be installed in the city. Money to be taken from the Capital Reserve and to be reimbursed from the PCCD Police Equipment Grant.
4. A motion to approve payment to Ford Office Technologies in the amount of \$50,165.70 for computer equipment upgrades for the police department, Money to be taken from the Capital Reserve and to be reimbursed from the PCCD Police Equipment Grant.
5. A motion to Transfer \$57,000 from the Capital Reserve to the General Fund for the interest that was budgeted for 2023.
6. A motion to Transfer \$63,157.86 from the Act 205 Account to the General Fund for reimbursement for the 2023 MMO payment.
7. A motion to reimburse Chad Krawtz \$300.00 for his attendance to the Local Government Academy for a newly elected course.
