**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JEANNETTE
APPROVING A REVISION TO THE FY 2021 CDBG PROGRAM YEAR**

A Resolution of the City Council of Jeannette, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, authorizing the submission of a revision to the FY 2021 application to the Pennsylvania Department of Community and Economic Development for funding through the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program, as authorized under the Housing and Community Development Act [42 USC 5301 and 24 CFR Part 570], and further certifying compliance with the requirements of said program.

WHEREAS, the City Council of Jeannette has the legal authority and responsibility under Act 179 to apply for Community Development Block Grant funds; and

WHEREAS, the City Council discussed the reduction in the Downtown Improvements (Clay Avenue Phase VI) line item from \$158,419.99 to \$157,260.54 and a corresponding increase in the Clearance/Demolition line item from \$39,419.01 to \$40,578.46 at the City Council Meeting; and

WHEREAS, the Downtown Improvements (Clay Avenue Phase VI) activity was completed and there is a budget surplus of \$1,159.45 which could partially fund the Clearance/Demolition activity.

WHEREAS, the City's Community Development Office has prepared a Program Revision to utilize the \$1,159.45 from the Clay Avenue activity to partially fund the Clearance/Demolition activity.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Jeannette that its Mayor is authorized to submit this revision to the FY 2021 CDBG Program Year to the Department of Community and Economic

Development for Community Development Block Grant funds for the purposes aforesaid; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, if CDBG funds are determined by the Pennsylvania Department of Community and Economic Development to be expended on ineligible program costs or do not meet a national objective, the City of Jeannette agrees to repay the proportion deemed ineligible from non-federal sources.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor of the City of Jeannette is empowered to place his signature, on behalf of the governing body, on necessary application forms and affix thereto the official seal of the City of Jeannette.
