AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF JEANNETTE  
AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 70-5, BY FURTHER  
DEFINING DISORDERLY CONDUCT

BE IT ordained and enacted and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the Council of the City of Jeannette, at a regular meeting thereof, held on the 15<sup>TH</sup> day of FEBRUARY, 1989 that,

Whereas, Council has the specific authority pursuant to 53 P.S. 37403(55) to define disorderly conduct within the City and to provide the imposition of penalties for such conduct, and;

Whereas, Council desires to further define disorderly conduct,

Now, therefore, in consideration of the above, Council adopts the following:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 70-5 is hereby amended to include the following:

1. Disorderly shall be further defined to include any person who shall possess any opened container of alcoholic beverages or who shall consume any alcoholic beverages in the parks, public parking lots or on the streets, alleys and sidewalks in the City to the annoyance of peaceable residents nearby or traveling upon any street or alley or being lawfully upon any public grounds of the City.

Section 2. All other portions of the previous ordinance are hereby confirmed and continued in full force and effect.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage.
