ORDINANCE NO. 89 - 5

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 74-12,
PROVIDING FOR A CHANGE IN SECTION III (a)
LOWERING THE AGE FOR JEANNETTE JUNIOR
AUXILIARY FIREMEN'S ASSOCIATION TO
FOURTEEN (14) YEARS OF AGE

Be it ordained and enacted and it is hereby ordained
and enacted by the Council of the City of Jeannette, at a regular
meeting thereof, held on the 5TH day of APRIL, 1989, that,

Whereas, Council has received a recommendation from the
Fire Department to consider lowering the age limitation for
Junior Auxiliary Firemen, and;

Whereas, Council is desirous of lowering the age for
eligible membership in the Junior Firemen's Auxiliary;

Now, therefore, in consideration of the above, Council
adopts the following:

Section I. Section III (a) of Ordinance No. 74-12 shall
be amended to read as follows:

a. That the age requirement established shall not be
less than fourteen (14) nor more than eighteen (18) years of age.

Section II: Any candidates eligible because of this
amendment must also comply with requirements of any state and
federal laws or statutes dealing with work certifications.

Section III: All other provisions of the aforesaid
previous ordinance are hereby ratified and approved.

Section IV: This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage.
