ORDINANCE NO. 89 - 11

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF JEANNETTE
PROHIBITING THE USE OF BICYCLES,
SKATEBOARDS OR OTHER VEHICLES UPON THE
SIDEWALKS WITHIN THE CENTRAL BUSINESS
DISTRICT OF THE CITY OF JEANNETTE.

BE IT ordained and enacted and it is hereby ordained
and enacted by the Council of the City of Jeannette, at a regular
meeting thereof held on the 20TH day of SEPTEMBER, 1989,
that;

WHEREAS, Council has the specific authority as contained
in 53 P.S. 37403 (29) and (30) to prevent racing; dangerous
practices; et. cetera and riding or driving on sidewalks, and;

WHEREAS, the use and operation of skateboards and
bicycles on sidewalks within the central business district of the
City of Jeannette endangers the health and safety of pedestrians
who travel along the aforesaid sidewalks, and;

WHEREAS, Council desires to promote the health and
safety of the citizens of the City;

NOW, THEREFORE, Council adopts the following:

1. The central business district for purposes of this ordinance shall include the area bounded by Magee Avenue on the north and Bullitt Avenue on the south and First Street on the east and Ninth Street on the west.
2. The operation and use of bicycles and skateboards over sidewalks within the central business district shall be unlawful.
3. Anyone violating this ordinance shall be subject to a fine of not more than Fifty and no/100 (\$50.00) Dollars.


4. If any portion of this ordinance is determined to be unconstitutional, the surviving portions shall be deemed valid and continue in force and effect.
5. Any ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
