Ordinance No. 90 - 10

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF JEANNETTE
PROVIDING FOR A LEFT TURN AT THE
INTERSECTION OF CLAY AVENUE AND FOURTH
STREET FOR AUTOMOBILES ONLY

Be it ordained and enacted and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the Council of the City of Jeannette at a regular meeting thereof, held on the 19th day of December, 1990 that

WHEREAS, the City of Jeannette has the specific power to prevent or regulate the riding or driving of any vehicle over, along and across sidewalks, and to regulate the passing of the same through the streets, as contained in 53 P.S. 37403 (30), and;

WHEREAS, the City Council is desirous of regulating the traffic movement on Clay Avenue, at its intersection with Fourth Street to allow for a left turn from Fourth onto Clay Avenue;

NOW, therefore, in consideration of the above, Council adopts the following:

1. Automobiles traveling on South Fourth Street, in a general northerly direction shall be permitted to turn left onto Clay Avenue at the intersection.

2. All truck traffic shall be prohibited from turning left onto Clay Avenue.

3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

4. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage.

5. Any violation of this ordinance shall be treated in the same manner as prescribed under the motor vehicle code for making an illegal turn.
