Ordinance No. 83 - 4

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF JEANNETTE VACATING  
A CERTAIN UNIMPROVED PORTION OF WOODLAND  
AVENUE DEDICATED AS A PUBLIC RIGHT  
OF WAY BUT NEVER ACCEPTED BY THE MUNICIPALITY.

Be it ordained and enacted, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the Council of the City of Jeannette, at a regular meeting thereof, held on the 14<sup>TH</sup> day of DECEMBER, 1983 that,

WHEREAS, the owners of property abutting that portion of unimproved street described in "Schedule A" attached hereto and made a part hereof, have petitioned the Council to vacate same, and;


WHEREAS, the aforesaid portion of unimproved street has been reviewed by the City Engineer, Fire Chief and Police Chief, and further no harm or danger to the public health or safety would result from the proposed vacation.

NOW, therefore, in consideration of the above, and in further consideration of the recommendations of the City officers aforesaid and intending to be legally bound hereby, Council adopts the following:

1. That portion of the within described unimproved right of way be and is hereby vacated.
2. The premises hereby vacated shall revert to and become the property of the adjoining property owners from the centerline of the existing right of way.
3. The City reserves unto itself, its successors or assigns any existing right of way or easements for sanitary or storm sewers for the express purpose of maintenance, repair or replacement.
4. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage.


5. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
