ORDINANCE NO. 87- 4

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF JEANNETTE AMENDING A CERTAIN PORTION OF ORDINANCE NO. 63-10 PROVIDING FOR THE EXTENSION OF TIME WITHIN WHICH BURNING MAY BE CONDUCTED.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the Council of the City of Jeannette, at a regular meeting thereof held on the 18<sup>th</sup> day of March, 1987, that

WHEREAS: Council for the City of Jeannette has received numerous requests to expand the period for the permissible burning as set forth in Ordinance No. 63-10, and,

WHEREAS: Council is desirous of providing an extended period for such permissible burning.

NOW, THEREFORE, Council adopts the following:

SECTION 1: That Section 111 of Ordinance No. 63-10 is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 111: The said burning shall be conducted only on private property and said burning may be conducted only between the hours of 2:00 P.M. to 7:00 P.M. local time, on Fridays and Saturdays, and on no other days, provided further that said burning may be conducted on any day from November 1 through and including November 30 of each year within the same time periods; and a competent person shall be in attendance at all times while said burning is taking place. Such burning site shall be located a safe distance from any buildings and other structures so as to prevent any fire hazard. Said burning must be carried out in such a manner as to prevent the emission of noxious or offensive smoke or odor.


SECTION 11. The specific intention of this amendment is to expand the period granted for permissible burning to include any day in the month of November, from the first through the 30th.

SECTION 111. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent here-  
with are hereby repealed.
