**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JEANNETTE
APPROVING A REVISION TO THE FY 2023 CDBG PROGRAM YEAR**

A Resolution of the City Council of the City of Jeannette, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, authorizing the submission of a revision to the FY 2023 application to the Pennsylvania Department of Community and Economic Development (DCED) for funding through the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program, as authorized under the Housing and Community Development Act [42 USC 5301 and 24 CFR Part 570], and further certifying compliance with the requirements of said program.

WHEREAS, the City Council of Jeannette has the legal authority and responsibility under Act 179 to apply for Community Development Block Grant funds; and

WHEREAS, the City Council discussed the reduction in the Sellers Avenue improvements line item from \$90,726.00 to \$34,862.01, and a corresponding increase in the park cameras line items from \$40,999.00 to \$96,862.99 at the City Council Meeting; and

WHEREAS, the City received a grant from the State for Sellers Avenue improvements activity to complete all outstanding costs, and there is a surplus of funds in that line item activity; and

WHEREAS, the City of Jeannette is familiar with the requirements of the program as provided for in the Housing and Community Development Act (HCDA) and the Community Development Block Grant regulations; and

WHEREAS, the City received bids for the installation of cameras in the city parks, which is over the budget amount by \$55,863.99; and

WHEREAS, the City of Jeannette wishes to revise its budget for the FY 2023 CDBG funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Jeannette that its Mayor is authorized to submit this revision to the FY 2023 CDBG Program Year to the Department of Community and Economic Development for Community Development Block Grant funds for the purposes aforesaid; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, if CDBG funds are determined by the Pennsylvania Department of Community and Economic Development to be expended on ineligible program costs or do not meet a national objective, the City of Jeannette agrees to repay the proportion deemed ineligible from non-federal sources.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor of the City of Jeannette is empowered to place her signature on behalf of the governing body, on necessary application forms, and affix thereto the official seal of the City of Jeannette.
